- ➡ 4 All prints must be mounted **on thin cardboard only**. This means the photos should be glued to thin cardboard, same size as the photo or slightly larger to create a border, e.g. 8"x10" photo on 10"x12" board.
- 5 No framed or matted photos will be accepted. A matted photo is one which is attached to a backing board and a windowed matte goes over the top of the photos, giving an external 3D bordered effect.
- 6 Prints can be a minimum of 5"x7" to a maximum 11"x14".
